We use a multi-disciplinary team approach on these difficult cases.

The team is made up of Crimes Against Children Detectives, CPS Investigators, Prosecutors from the County Attorney and District Attorney's offices, Juvenile Services, Cook Children's Medical Center CARE Team, Therapists, Forensic Interviewers, Family Advocates, K-9 Advocates, and Therapy Dogs and their amazing handlers.

Child victims served by the center have suffered sexual abuse, severe physical abuse, witnessed a homicide or violent crime and/or have been seriously endangered by drug exposure.
